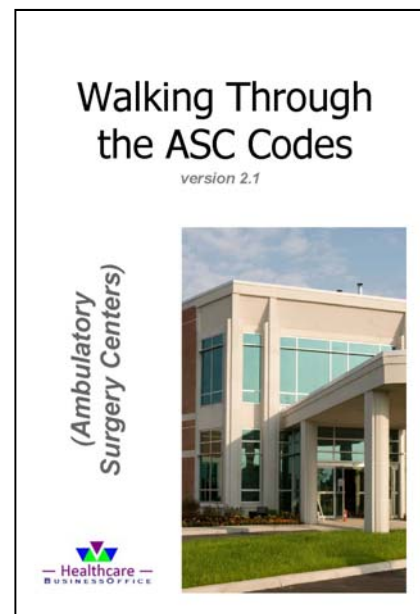


Walking Through the ASC Codes (Ambulatory Surgery Centers)

Walking Through the ASC Codes (Ambulatory Surgery Centers) is a comprehensive CD-ROM based interactive course. There are more than 5,000 ambulatory surgery centers in the United States. ASCs now perform over 22 million outpatient surgery services a year. With medical technology advancing medical services each year, more and more procedures are done on an outpatient basis.

- Chapter 7: ENT; commonly reported ENT services such as nasal endoscopy, rhinoplasty, septoplasty, tonsillectomy
- Chapter 8: Plastic surgery; including procedures like facelift, liposuction, breast augmentation, eyelid services
- Chapter 9: Gynecology; services such as tubal ligation, hysteroscopy, and laparoscopy
- Chapter 10: Gastroenterology; including endoscopy, colonoscopy, and other services
- Chapter 11: Modifiers for ASCs; an in-depth discussion of modifiers appropriate for use in ASCs, including usage and guidelines
