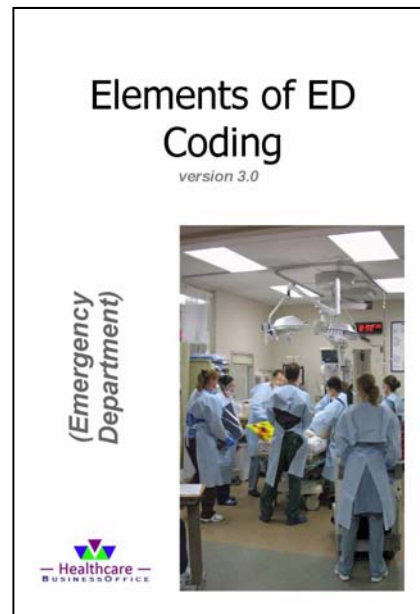


# Elements of ED Coding (Emergency Department)

- Chapter 5: Dislocations — defining and coding dislocations of the more common joints seen in the ED
- Chapter 6: Fractures — review of upper and lower limb fractures, including treatments, code selection and techniques
- Chapter 7: Eyes and Ears — review abscess and drainage of the eyes and ears; services and code usage involved
- Chapter 8: Foreign Body Removal — regarding removal from eyes, ears, throat, and GI; services and code usage
- Chapter 9: Wound Repair — wounds of the trunk, scalp, arms, ears, and more; codes, classifications, guidelines
- Chapter 10: Pulmonary — spirometry services, lung measurement, bronchodilation, inhalation; codes and usage
