

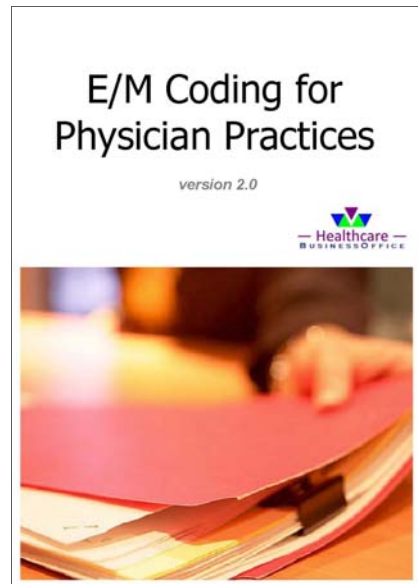
E/M Coding for Physician Practices
