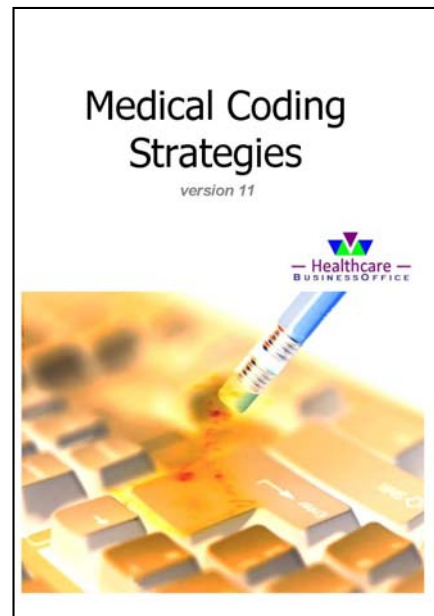


Medical Coding Strategies
