

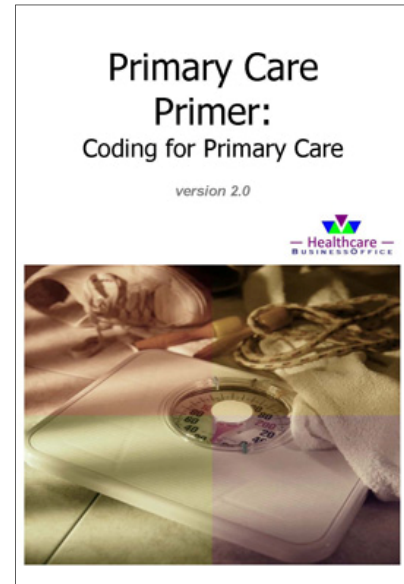
Primary Care Primer: Coding for Primary Care

Primary care providers traditionally provided basic and non-surgical services of common illnesses, injuries, and medical conditions, and include those in family practice, general practitioners, and internal medicine.

However, in an effort to provide a more inclusive service, many primary care providers are now providing in-office EKGs, treatment for simple fractures, counseling for patients on life-affecting habits regarding dieting, exercising, and smoking cessation, and sometimes even providing OB services and more.
